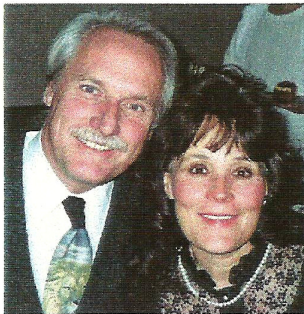

Greetings in Jesus to all!

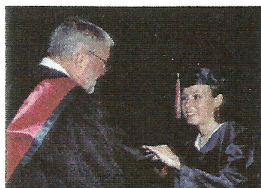

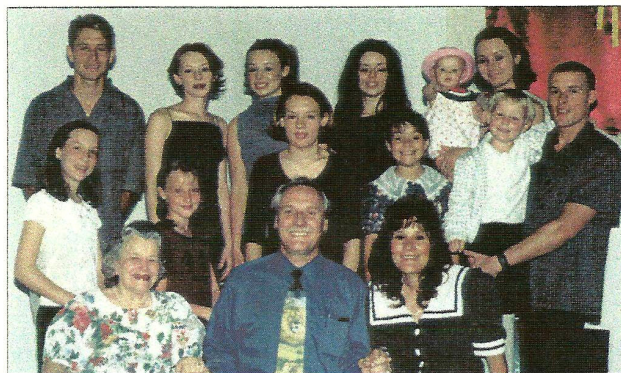

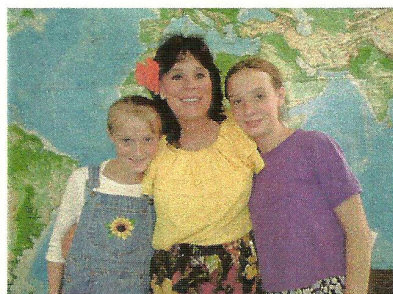
