



The theme for the Summer School was the Gospel of Mark. We read all 16 chapters aloud and exhorted on them with the children. For most of them it was their first time to actually read an entire

We were blessed with a special guest from Atlanta, Georgia during June, Coach Clark who holds the world record for speed jump rope. His ministry is called



"Jumpin for Jesus" and may we suggest you contact him for any school or children/youth related ministry. He will teach your kids how to skip rope and quote scripture simultaneously. Our own dear John David could only do one jump on the first day. By quoting Philippians 4:13 and persevering he completed 63 jumps the next day and can quote the Books of the Bible while jumping rope now!

We were able to film a segment of Coach Clark's jumping rope along with his best jumpers. In just 5 days these children mastered quite a few skills. During June we took

a weekend in Brenham, Texas to minister to the children of EFC Churches of Houston. It was a joy to be sharing the gospel again with Chinese children. We had more than a dozen children come to know Christ in a definite decision and were once again thrilled to see God's Word not return void but accomplish His pleasure. Isaiah 55:10-12

During this time Mr Steve had his 52 birthday and was blessed to have the prayers of Pastor Park and all the children.




more school and children's ministries can visit such an educational and blessed place.






