TV Program



Mr Steve took a group of teen to an Acquire the Fire event at the Astro Arena last week. Over 6,000 teens were present and impacted by the ministry of Teen Mania via video, lights, sound, multi-media and teaching. We were encouraged to see so many teens respond to the altar call and also to the challenge to fast all media (movies, TV, radio etc) for 30 days and begin a read through the Bible.

We learned graphically how today's Modern Media-

First GLAZES us. Uses entertainment to capture our attention and money

Then HAZES us (zombies us, clouds our brain) After an average of 38% of our waking hours bombarded with these signals.

And lastly, RAISES us. Teaches us our life values, becomes our parents.

Today's teens are determined to be "smarter" than that by resisting images imposed upon us via the money Masters of the Media. Unshakeable! Unmoveable was the theme.

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

A few years ago we were traveling to California to minister at a conference. We were traveling with 8 of our children and one person

to help with the equipment.


