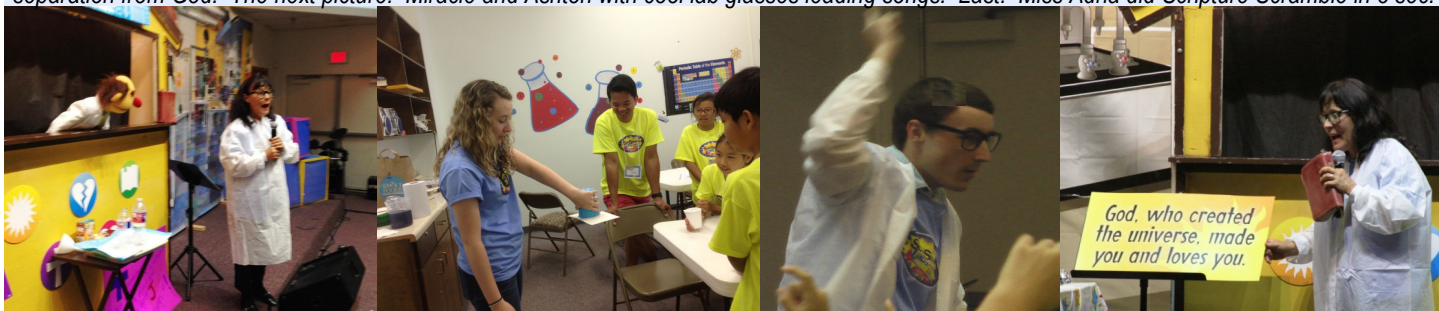
Wonderful prayer at VBS

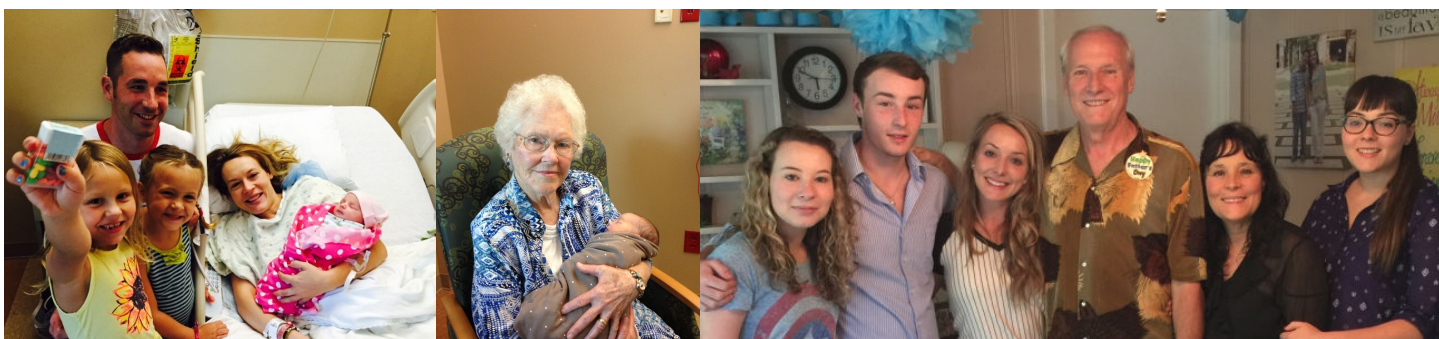

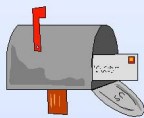
Dear Friends,
