





That's right, Mercy and Johnny, boys and girls! We need to know God's Word by heart like we learn our ABC's.

You say it over and over a little at a time until you know a whole verse by heart. That's memorizing the Word of God! Your HEART is the best place to hide the Bible.






Well, Johnny, here's a story that Miss Adria tells that might help you understand.


In the beginning there was the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in Heaven.

God told them they could eat of every tree of the garden except for one. That was the tree of the "knowledge of good and evil".




She gave some to Adam and he ate it too! And when they ate the

In the first part of the Bible, called the Old Testament, people had to sacrifice a perfect lamb each year to cover their sins.




That lamb shed his blood to cover the sins of the ones who sacrificed it.

Just pray:



If I were a sheep, I'd be glad the shepherd has a rod and a staff!



The shepherd has to walk through the table land and pull out any poisonous plants or weeds that may make the sheep sick. He prepares the table land for them and also removes thorn bushes. He may even have to use some rocks to make a still pool for the sheep to

drink from. Remember, they don't like running water.



Pray this prayer:


